WHY WE NEED YOUR HELP

Your support will help Kiwi kids with cancer and the people who love them.

- Every week at least three Kiwi kids are diagnosed with cancer.
- Child cancer affects the whole family; brothers, sisters, mum, dad, and whānau.
- Right now we help over 1,700 families across New Zealand with personalised support.
- We are with them every step of the way.
- We need to raise \$6 million each year to provide this vital support to Kiwi kids and their families.
- Child Cancer Foundation receives no direct government funding and we rely entirely on donations.

COLLECTING GUIDELINES

You will be issued with a Child Cancer Foundation bib or sash, bucket, thank you stickers and banking bag.

Do's

- **DO** wear the bib or sash at all times while collecting.
- **DO** be polite and friendly. Be sure to greet pedestrians and highlight the key messages above.
- **DO** stay at your site. This is where we have permission to collect. Please ensure you know where any emergency exits are if you are in a mall or supermarket. Please consider your safety and that of others at all times.

Don'ts

- **DON'T** block or impede access on footpaths, pedestrian crossings or outside businesses.
- **DON'T** attempt to remove the bucket lid. They are sealed and site supervisors only remove them for emptying. We are unable to give change but please suggest they donate online through our website.

- **RECEIPTS:** If a receipt is requested please take their details and pass these to the site supervisor. We are only able to receipt amounts over \$5.00.
- **SAFETY:** Your safety is important to us - in the unlikely event that a member of the public threatens you, hand over your bucket. Immediately call your supervisor or 111.
- **END OF YOUR COLLECTION TIME:** If the next volunteer doesn't arrive on time and you have to leave, please contact your site supervisor. If you are unable to contact them please leave the bucket in a secure place e.g. a local bank to hold the bucket and let your site supervisor know where you have left the items. Alternatively take them home with you and advise your site supervisor.

NO CASH OR COINS?

If pedestrians say 'I don't have any cash or coins on me', please encourage them to make their donation on our website.

HANDLING MONEY:

At the end of the day when it's time to use the banking bag, two people **MUST** supervise the money being transferred from the bucket to the banking bag.

BANKING:

If you have been asked to bank money using the banking bag supplied you must take ID with you to the bank - refer to the bag for details.
